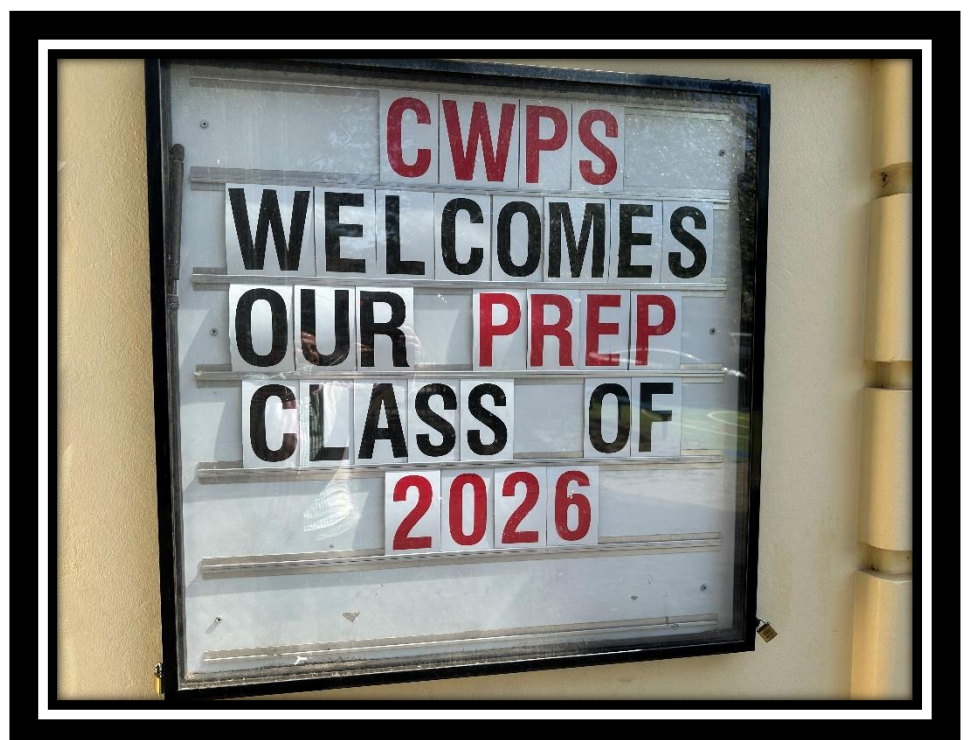
### Classroom Cuisine Deliver to CWPS

# Introducing CLIL Visual Arts and Italian at Coburg West Primary School

**Benvenuti al nuovo anno scolastico!** (*Welcome to the new school year!*)

As we begin a new school year, we are delighted to welcome all our families and to introduce an exciting addition to our curriculum: **CLIL Visual Arts and Italian**.

This year, students will have the opportunity to explore Visual Arts while also learning the Italian language in a natural and engaging way.

**CLIL** stands for *Content and Language Integrated Learning*. It is an approach where students learn a subject—Visual Arts—through a foreign language. In our case, students will explore creative art activities while also learning Italian.

## Why Visual Arts and Italian?

Visual Arts is a highly visual, practical subject, making it an excellent choice for second language learning. Students can understand new words and phrases through images, demonstrations, gestures, and hands-on activities. This means they can successfully follow lessons and express themselves creatively, even with little or no prior knowledge of Italian.

## What will lessons look like?

During CLIL Visual Arts lessons:

- Italian will be introduced gradually using simple vocabulary and phrases
- Key language will be repeated and reinforced naturally
- Visual aids and teacher modelling will support understanding
- English will be used where necessary to ensure clarity and inclusion

The focus remains firmly on **developing artistic skills and creativity**, with Italian used as the language of learning rather than an additional subject to be tested.

## Benefits for Students

CLIL Visual Arts and Italian supports student learning in many ways:

- Encourages early language awareness in a relaxed, pressure-free environment
- Builds confidence in listening to and using a new language

- Enhances thinking skills such as problem-solving, memory, and flexibility
- Promotes creativity and self-expression
- Develops cultural awareness and curiosity about the wider world

**Inclusive and accessible for all**

No previous knowledge of Italian is required. CLIL is designed to be inclusive, and lessons are carefully planned so all students can participate, enjoy, and succeed.

By introducing CLIL Visual Arts and Italian, we aim to enrich our curriculum, spark curiosity, and give students valuable skills that will support future learning—all while having fun and being creative.

We look forward to sharing students’ artwork and experiences with you as the new CLIL program develops.
