Structured Word Inquiry

For this week's home learning, we want you to find different prefixes and suffixes while you are reading!

Open a book to any page and write down at least 5 words with a prefix and 5 different words with a suffix.

Remember, a prefix is at the start of a base and a suffix is added to the end of a base.

Once you have found your words, write them as word sums to show their prefixes and suffixes.

For example: my first prefix is /re/, like in the word replaying.
My word sum would be re + play + ing → replaying.
