## HEAD LICE

Despite having the holiday break, we are still dealing with many cases of head lice across our junior grades in particular. We urge all families to continue checking their child's hair, ensuring that if head lice are present, they are treated correctly. We ask that your child does not return to school until after they have been treated. Please also notify the school or your class teacher if your child has head lice. Following in this newsletter is more information.



## **COLD, FLU & COVID**

As we move into winter, we are faced with the onset of colds and flu season. Added to this, we still have COVID cases occurring across our community. As such, please ensure your child does not attend school if they are unwell, in particular if they show any symptoms which could spread illness. Please be reminded that we have Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) kits available for collection from the office if you should require them.

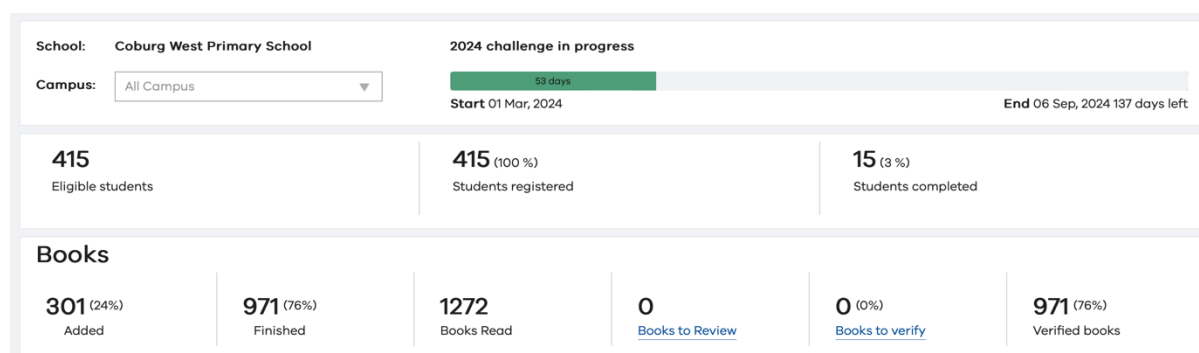

***They're Back .....***

Dear Parents/Guardians/Carers,

It has come to my attention that some students in the school may have head lice and I seek your cooperation in checking your child's hair.

Head lice do not transmit infectious diseases – they are transmitted by having head-to-head contact with someone who has head lice. You may be reassured to know that head lice are commonly found in places other than at Coburg West Primary School. Head lice are common in school-aged children and are the most adaptable of creatures. They have survived living solely on humans for 10,000 years!!!!

What can you do?

I seek your cooperation in checking your child's hair and in those instances where head lice or eggs are found, treating your child's hair. Please visit [www.betterhealth.vic.gov.au](http://www.betterhealth.vic.gov.au) and search for "head lice (nits)" for advice on finding, [treating](#) and preventing head lice.

The school also has additional information available regarding treatment and controlling head lice.

If head lice or eggs are found on your child's hair you need to inform:

- the school and advise when the treatment [has](#) started, via the attached *Action Taken Form*.
- parents or carers of your child's friends so they too [have the opportunity to detect](#) and treat their children if necessary.

When can my child return to school?

Health regulations requires that where a child has head lice, that child should not return to school until the day after appropriate treatment has started. Please note, this refers only to those children who have live head lice and does not refer to head lice eggs. More information about exclusion requirements can be found by searching for "school exclusion table" at [www.health.vic.gov.au](http://www.health.vic.gov.au).

Coburg West Primary School is aware that head lice can be a sensitive issue and is committed to maintaining your confidentiality.

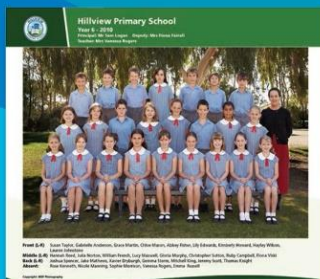

# SMILE SQUAD IS COMING BACK TO CWPS

Dear Coburg West Primary School families,

The Smile Squad team from Merri Health are coming to our school soon. Smile Squad is the Victorian Government free school dental program. This means all students can get a free dental check-up, preventive services, and treatment at school.

We need your consent before we can provide services. Consent is usually provided by a parent or guardian.

## Smile Squad dental packs

All children deserve a healthy smile, and the Smile Squad free school dental program is working hard to help make sure this happens.

Your child(ren) will soon receive a free dental pack to bring home. The dental pack contains a toothbrush, full sized toothpaste, and an oral health brochure. Please take the time to read the brochure. It's full of helpful hints and tips to help your whole family eat well, drink well and clean well – for life.

## Standard strength toothpaste

Smile Squad provides standard strength fluoride toothpaste that is generally used by ages six and over, unless recommended by a dental or trained health professional.

If your child is under six, please talk to a dental or trained health professional to find out if your child might benefit from using this toothpaste. You can also choose to put the toothpaste away until they turn six or give it to someone else in your family to use.

## Do I need to attend my child's appointment?

No, you do not need to attend your child's appointment. You can attend if you would like to, and you can take your child to the community dental clinic if you prefer.

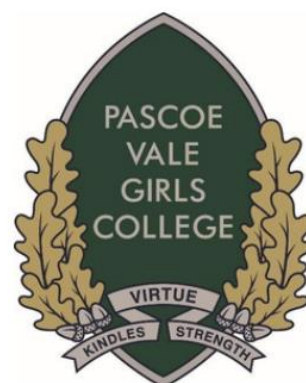
## Select Entry Accelerated Learning (SEAL)

SEAL provides personalised teaching and learning through a program, across Years 7-9, that meets the needs of gifted and talented learners. The program provides stimulating learning experiences that challenge, extend and develop the gifts and talents of students by offering acceleration and enrichment. The SEAL program at Pascoe Vale Girls College offers a faster paced curriculum with the opportunity to study concepts in greater depth. There is an emphasis on higher order thinking and learning skills. SEAL students are expected to be part of the school's instrumental music program including the orchestra in Years 7&8. In Year 10, SEAL students have the opportunity to accelerate their studies further by completing two VCE subjects earlier than their peers, which allows them to maximise their ATAR for tertiary entry.






### How to apply?

- Visit the school website [www.pvgc.vic.edu.au](http://www.pvgc.vic.edu.au), click on the Learning tab and then on SEAL. Students who wish to be considered for this program are required to sit an entrance test administered by Edutest (a fee applies). Registrations can be made through the link on the website.
- 2025 applications close on Monday 19th August and testing will be conducted at PVGC on Saturday 24th August, 2024. Information about the location, time and conditions of the test will be emailed closer to the date.

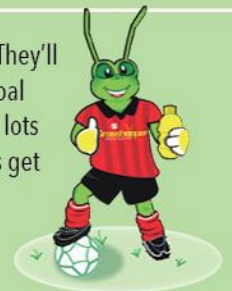
