Dear School Community,

While it has been wonderful to have students and staff back in our classrooms and filling our yard, it is hard to believe that the end of term is here already. I know, we have just come out of lockdown and it is very cold in the mornings, but we have noticed that many students are arriving after the 9am bell. I remind everyone that instructional learning time begins at 9am sharp and it does not benefit your child to miss that learning time. Last year we introduced the entry to classrooms with the 8:50am bell, to ensure students had that 10 minutes of 'Get ready for learning' time, so as to maximise instructional time in every classroom. I ask everyone to have students onsite and in classrooms prior to the 9am bell.

COVID RESTRICTIONS UPDATE

As advised in my COMPASS notification Thursday afternoon, restrictions in all Victorian Government Schools have changed. It has now been mandated by DET, that **no person is permitted to enter a school building without having registered their attendance using the QR Codes**. These QR Codes can now be found at every school gate and entry point to a building. If anyone is unable to register with the QR Code, they must attend the front office and register their attendance via VPass. Staff and students are not required to register.

Face masks should still be carried by each person and worn when social distancing is not possible. They **must** also be worn by anyone entering a school building.

Given these restrictions, the **Parent Helpers program will not be able to recommence until Term 3**. Likewise, the Parent and Teacher Meetings being held next Wednesday 23rd June, will need to be held by phone.

I would like to congratulate staff, students and parents/carers for the smooth transition back into Remote and Flexible Learning. Especially given the short notice, I feel our staff did an amazing job at making that shift to online teaching and learning, a calm and easy one yet again. I know from the many positive comments at the school gates and the emails of gratitude, that the majority of our families felt well supported. While we were fortunate that this last lockdown was a brief one, I am sure that by working together and supporting one another, we will ensure that all students are continuing their learning journeys regardless of whether it is online or face to face.

SCHOOL NURSE

I would also like to thank our amazing School Nurse Sue for continuing her great work throughout the lockdown. Sue does an amazing job every day of the school year, ensuring that every child that enters the Sick Bay for First Aid attention, is treated with care and respect. In speaking with Sue, it is interesting to note that already this year, to the month of April, a total of 2,748 student visits had been recorded. This is interesting when compared to the year-end totals from previous years;

- 2019 saw a total of 7,882 student visits to Sick Bay
- 2020 saw a total of 4,659 student visits to Sick Bay

Whether it be for a paper cut, sore belly, medication or something more serious, Sue records every visit. Therefore, we thank every family who has already paid the \$90 Voluntary Contribution per child to help cover the service of having a school nurse onsite. When you think about it, this is less than fifty cents a day to have someone on hand to care for your child if ever it should be required.




