#### PROFESSIONAL LEARNING

Our Curriculum Day this past Wednesday, was spent working collaboratively with the staff from Merri-Bek Primary School. Staff from both schools spent the day working with Michael Ymer, who is a highly regarded maths consultant. It was a full day, with staff working collaboratively, exploring hands-on maths activities that challenged their thinking while also exploring practical strategies and techniques for assessing, differentiating, and managing maths lessons. The staff across both schools valued the opportunity to learn together, share ideas and simply network. It has also been wonderful to see so many teachers already trialling and applying their learning into their maths lessons in the few days since then.

#### **SCHOOL DISCO**

It was wonderful to see so many students attending the School Disco last Friday night. Equally as pleasing was to see the smiles on the faces of the parents and carers as they picked up their excited and, in some cases, exhausted children. A mountain of gratitude goes out to the many parents and staff who gave up their time to assist the CWPS Community Group in running this Disco.

#### STAFFING DIFFICULTIES


As reported in the news media, there is currently a shortage of teaching staff across the state. We have been trying to recruit a Performing Arts teacher since last term without success. We are currently on our fourth attempt to recruit. Likewise, it is becoming more and more difficult to engage Casual Relief Teachers (CRTs) to replace staff who fall ill. There are just not enough CRTs around and demand across schools is extremely high. As such, we find ourselves having to split classes more often than we would like. We are doing our utmost to provide consistency for all students, but as we move into the winter cold and flu season, this is going to become more of an issue. We ask that you show patience and understand the difficulties we are facing.

#### **SCHOOL NURSE**

Many of you would know of Sue, our School Nurse. Not only does she assist all children as they visit First Aid throughout the day, but she also attended the School Disco last Friday night to provide care for our students as required throughout the night.

As you know, parents can make a voluntary contribution payment each year to help our school provide this service. These payments can be made via COMPASS or at the office by phone or over the counter.
