Needless to say, so many of you, were happy to usher them back in to onsite learning. Thankfully this last lockdown was brief and the students all settled straight back into full learning programs.

A big thanks to those families who sent in messages thanking staff for their efforts throughout this round of Remote and Flexible Learning, but on behalf of all staff, I wish to thank each of you for supporting your children in their learning from home.

We do however, all still need to each do our part to keep our school community safe. I urge each of you to follow the current restrictions which are in place and ensure we are setting the right examples for all our children. Please ensure that you all;

- Wear a correctly fitted face mask both indoors and outdoors (includes anywhere on school grounds)

## PARENT/CAREGIVER/GUARDIAN OPINION SURVEY

In the coming week, I will be emailing each of you an invite to complete the annual Parent/Caregiver/Guardian Opinion Survey. This email invitation will contain a link to the survey and it should take you approximately 20 minutes to complete. While the survey asks you a variety of questions relating to you child's learning, the staff, the school and your general satisfaction, this year it also includes questions relating to your experience of remote and flexible learning.

We hope that as many of you as possible will take the time to complete this survey. The Department of Education issue this survey each year and it assists both DET and our school to gauge the general feelings of our school community. We value this information and feedback as it provides us with a broad range of areas to reflect upon and aim to improve each year.

The survey will be open until Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September.

#### **CAPITAL WORKS PROJECT**

Last year I submitted a grant application to the DET, which was successful. It granted our school a large sum of funding to make upgrades to our learning spaces in the current grade 1/2 area. The overall project will be managed by the Victorian School Buildings Authority (VSBA).

In the last fortnight, I was informed by the VSBA that they have completed the tender process and we now have an Architect to work with. In the coming week, I will be meeting with the architect to start discussion, measurements and planning for this project.

The aim of this project is to install dividing walls and windows between the classroom spaces to improve the acoustics and reduce the distractions to students learning. I will keep our community informed of our progress. However, like any building works, there is a process to go through, but it is hoped that the work will be completed in time for the start of the 2022 school year.

#### **COBURG WEST SCHOOL COMMUNITY GROUP EVENTS**

I wish to thank Meg and her team on the flexibility and persistence in keeping their work going as we move in and out of lockdowns, with ever changing restrictions. I know that the Disco has been rescheduled, as has the Trivia Night. The Shore Reserve Showdown has a date for the match and the team are in training. The Family Pie Drive was a huge hit, as are the Beanies. There is still the Bunnings BBQ coming up, along with a few other events. 

# WE WANT OUR PARENTS/CAREGIVERS/GUARDIANS TO TELL US WHAT THEY THINK!

Our school is conducting a survey to find out what parents/caregivers/guardians think of our school. The Parent/Caregiver/Guardian Opinion Survey is an annual survey offered by the Department of Education and Training that is conducted amongst parents/caregivers/guardians (previously known as the Parent Opinion Survey). It is designed to assist schools in gaining an understanding of families' perceptions of school climate, student behaviour, student engagement and experiences of remote and flexible learning. Our school will use the survey results to help inform and direct future school planning and improvement strategies.

This year, all parents will be invited to participate in this year's survey. All responses to the survey are anonymous. This year, the Parent/Caregiver/Guardian Opinion Survey will be conducted through to **Friday 3**<sup>rd</sup> **September.** 

The survey will be conducted **online**, only takes **20 minutes** to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time within the fieldwork period on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones. The online survey will be available in a range of languages other than English. These include: Arabic, Vietnamese, Mandarin, Chin (Hakha), Hindi, Japanese, Somali, Turkish, Punjabi and Greek.
