Our Coburg West School Community Group have been working very hard in preparation for what I am sure will be an entertaining Twilight Market tomorrow (Saturday 22nd October). We had a swarm of volunteers across our school today, assisting with a range of preparations and I know that we are still needing many more to assist during the day. These events raise wonderful funds for our school and the Group have raised approximately \$23,000 so far this year. While these funds go towards improving our children's learning and play environments, the events themselves provide an amazing opportunity for our school community to come together, building friendships while having fun. We look forward to seeing as many of you as possible attending between 3pm and 8pm.

PARENT PAYMENTS

I wish to remind families who have not yet done so, that it is not too late to make your voluntary contributions for this 2022 school year. Unfortunately, at this stage of the year, only 61% of families have made these payments which is more than 20% down on this time last year. These payments can be made via the COMPASS App and will cover costs

incurred by our school to provide the **essential learning items** your children utilise to complete their daily learning tasks (eg pencil, paper and other stationary items, art supplies and sport equipment), as well as keeping our school nurse engaged to provide the daily care and support for the numerous children visiting First Aid each day.

ENROLMENTS FOR 2023

Yesterday we kicked off our transition program as we welcomed our new Prep students and their families into our classrooms for their Play and Stay session. 


New Moreland hard rubbish collection
