- Used by Prep to Grade 2
- Reminders from teachers
- Pics of your child learning at school







The basics


- We have a uniform policy
- Non-gendered, children can wear items they are comfortable in
- Warm weather = short sleeve polo + shorts/skorts or dress, hat
- Cold weather = pants/leggings + long sleeve polo or long sleeve polo/skivvy + pinafore, cardigan/jumper or zip-up vest
- Take home reader bag
- School bag



How many do I need?

For the child who does not prioritise cleanliness or keeping track of things...

- Tops: 3-5 of each
- Bottoms: 3-4 of each
- Dresses: 3-4/Pinafores: 2-3
- Cardigans/Jumpers: 3-4
- Hats: 2 no hat, no play policy




New

Secondhand

Label everything

- All the hats, jumpers and cardigans
- Drink bottles
- Lunch boxes
- Take home reader bags
- Label everything, did we say label? We mean label everything!

Lost Property

• 3 x lost property locations (Prep things mostly in prep locker area - near bike cage, grade 1/2 area - near gym, Out of School Hours Care)



What to pack?

Lunchbox

- Recess food (11am) = snack type food
- Brainfood (about 12.30pm) = fruit or veg, eaten while learning
- No nuts (some children have severe allergies)
- Lunch is from 1.30 2.30pm so cold things might need a cold pack
- We are working towards sustainable practice = Nude Food (no wrappers)

Bag

- Drink bottle label it
- Lunch box make sure they can open it, label it
- Take home reader bag also used for notices & forms (Check regularly)
- Change of clothes if you need it (The school Nurses has spares if 'accidents' occur)
- Library bag, once a week
- Art smock, stays at school
