<p><b>SEQUENCING</b> Write five events from your book. Sequence them by putting them in the correct order.</p>	<p><b>PREDICTING</b> Before you start the next chapter of your book, make a prediction about what you think will happen next. Then, after you read the chapter, tell whether or not your prediction was correct.</p>	<p><b>MONITORING</b> As you read, look for tricky words. Write them down. Then, use a dictionary to find out how to say them and what they mean. Write down the definitions.</p>
<p><b>QUESTIONING</b> Before you read the next chapter, write 5 questions about your book. Keep reading, and write the answers when you find them.</p>	<p><b>STUDENT CHOICE</b> Choose an activity that will help you practice reading strategies.
